(PATINA) is an educational 501 © 3 tax-exempt organization for People who have an interest in tools, crafts or manufacturing processes of the past. Based in the DC area, our 350+ members come from 24 states. Annual dues are \$15.00 and allow members and guests to participate in all events. Our mission is to promote and increase knowledge and understanding of the tools and trades practiced by our ancestors.

Our bimonthly meetings, held at American Legion Post 270 in McLean, Virginia generally start with <u>tailgating</u> sales around 9:00 AM or earlier, followed by a short tool auction around 11:00-11;30. The presentation by the guest speaker begins after the auction. Recent speakers included professional furniture makers, restorers, luthiers, period gun and coin manufacturing historians and others. Speakers are local artisans or national figures such as Roy Underhill of The Woodwright's Shop, or from museums including Colonial Williamsburg.

In 2025, our meetings will occur Sunday mornings in January, May, July, September & November.

In addition to the bimonthly meetings, PATINA hosts an annual Spring Dealer Sale and Auction in Damascus, MD

For 2025, the Spring Sale will occur on **Saturday**, **March 15** with dealer setup on Friday and Saturday. Early bird admission during setup is \$20.00. General Admission is FREE and open to the public.

Tailgating is also part of this event and extended a half mile in 2024.
